We continue to offer our popular "tree packs" which can be found on pages 15 & 16 of this price list.

This season we have good stocks of larger hedging plants, ideal for creating more of an instant hedge effect.

All our stock is grown from the best seed available and every care is used to supply stock to the highest quality true to name.

Please note that we are a tree nursery and not a garden centre. Whilst we are happy to accept small orders, we do ask that plants are ordered prior to collection. An order form is enclosed.

Prices:

All prices are quoted ex nursery and subject to VAT at the current rate.

We are pleased to quote discounted prices on larger orders (2000 + plants).

If you encounter any problems with calculating prices on your order, please do not hesitate to telephone.

Packing and Carriage/Collection:

Plants are lifted to order between mid October to late March. All orders are labelled and packed in suitable bags at no extra cost. We also offer container grown plants of some species for planting after March.

Orders can be collected from the nursery (by prior arrangement) between 8.00am - 1.00pm and 1.30pm - 5.30pm weekdays and 9.00am - 12.30pm Saturdays.

We will be pleased to quote for delivery of orders, either by our own transport or by next day carrier service, Minimum carriage charge is £20.00 + VAT per order.

Grant Applications, contract planting and maintenance:

We are able to supply wild flower and wild grass seed suitable for pond edges, hedgerows and woodlands. Please contact us if you would like details and prices. (These are offered subject to availability and only when placed with an order for trees or shrubs).

PLANTING GUIDE

It is important to remove all existing weeds from your proposed planting site before you start planting. Therefore, in early autumn (September/October) the area needs to be marked out and sprayed with an appropriate broad spectrum herbicide (e.g. roundup). If you are organic, or do not wish to use chemicals, then existing grass/weed needs to be physically removed before planting.

Late October through to late March are the best months for planting bare-root stock, but it is important to ensure that the ground is not waterlogged or frosted.

Plants should be notch planted (to the depth of the root collar), and then firmed in to ensure the roots have good contact with the soil to prevent the plants 'rocking' in the wind. A layer of organic mulch can be applied after planting to help reduce competition from grass and weeds.

The plants will need to be protected against damage by livestock, and consideration given as to the threat from vermin such as voles, rabbits and deer. We will be pleased to give advice on protection and which shelterguards/spirals might be required.

If you are establishing a new hedge plant two rows approximately 30cm (12in) apart (see diagram below). Plants should be staggered within these rows approximately 45 cm (18in) apart. This equates to between five and six plants per metre.

GENERAL MAINTENANCE

It is important to keep all new planting sites weed free for the first 2 years, as competition from grass and weeds will prevent the plants from establishing and growing strongly. This generally involves either spraying the area with a weed killer during the dormant period (November – February) or hand weeding during the spring. All plants should be examined for pest damage – i.e. aphids, rabbits voles etc. – and protection added if needed.

TERMS OF BUSINESS

The placing of an order will be held as acceptance of the conditions stated below:-

1. Prices are wholesale, ex-nursery and subject to VAT at the current rate.
2. We reserve the right to alter prices later in the season if necessary, if we need to buy in extra stock.
3. All plants are offered subject to being unsold on receipt of a firm order.
4. No complaints can be considered unless made within SEVEN DAYS of receiving the plants.

Settlement of Account

1. For orders collected from the nursery - all orders must be paid for on collection either by cash/cheque or credit/debit card.
2. Orders being delivered – all orders to be paid in full before dispatch
3. For approved customers only, settlement is due 30 days from the date of the invoice.
4. We reserve the right to charge 2.5% per month on overdue accounts.
5. It is understood that legal title to the goods supplied does not pass to the customer until full payment is received by ourselves.

Cancellations

1. Should an unfilled order be cancelled after the 31st December 2009, we reserve the right to charge 30% of the value of the order as liquidated damages.

We would be pleased to give advice on planting native hedging plants if required.

Before planting it is important to remove existing weeds in the hedge row by spraying or cultivation.

To establish a thick hedge, plant a double row with the rows 30cm apart. Planting should be staggered with the plants 40 - 45cm apart in the row (See page 18).
