# Planting Advice & General Maintenance

## Before you plant

Remove all existing weeds from your proposed site. Spray Glyphosate in early autumn (September/October) or if you are organic then weeds need to be removed by hand or machine.

## When to plant

Late October through until early April are the best months for planting bare-root stock, but it is important to ensure that the ground is not waterlogged or frosted.

## What to plant and where

The symbols below are designed to give you some idea as to what species are suited for certain growing conditions and uses. For a more detailed list please visit our website.

## How to plant

Plants should be notch planted (to the depth of the root collar), and then firmed in with your heel to ensure that the roots make good contact with the soil to prevent “rocking” in the wind. Larger plants will need to be pit planted in a prepared hole. A layer of well rotted mulch can be applied after planting to help reduce weed competition and retain moisture in the soil.

All plants need to be protected from damage against livestock, and consideration given to the threat from vermin such as voles, rabbits and deer. We will be pleased to give advice on protection and which shelterguards/spirals might be suitable.

## Instant hedging

As a rule we generally recommend planting smaller sized whips as these establish more quickly and are less prone to drought. However if you want more of an instant hedge effect or screen then we can supply the following varieties.

Most plants are 1+ metre in height. Unlike smaller 40-60cm plants, these will need more care after planting. Consideration must be given to watering and wind exposure.
